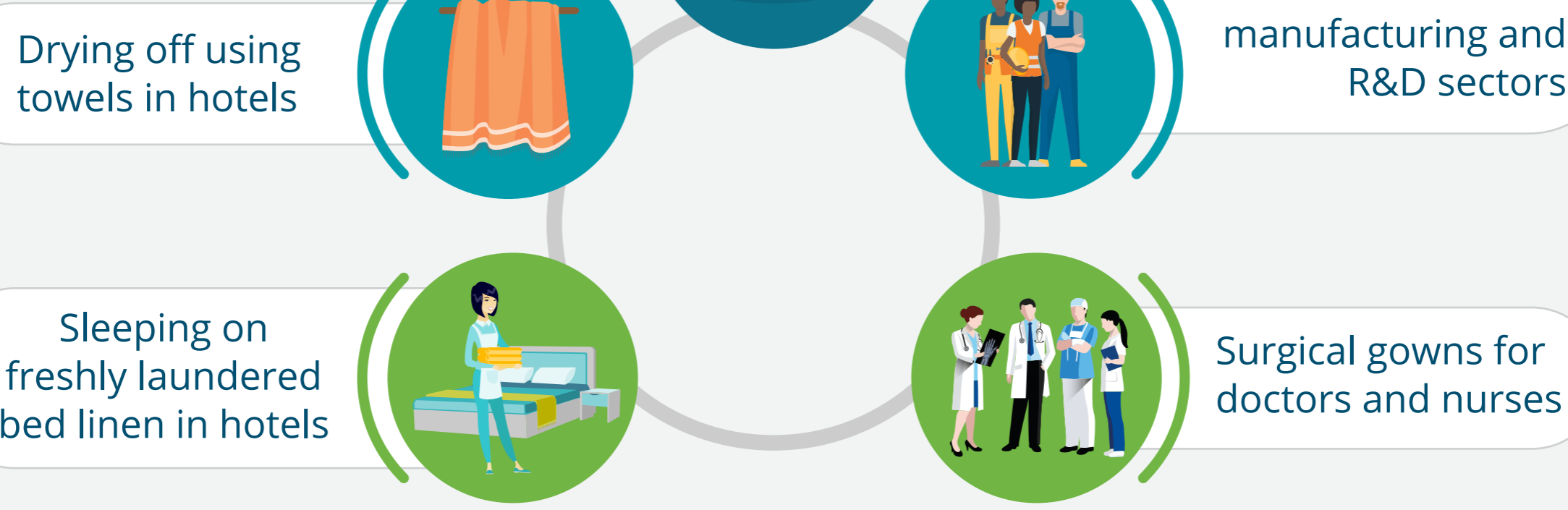
WHAT IS TEXTILE CARE?

MILLIONS OF TEXTILES ARE PROCESSED ON A DAILY BASIS



- On a weekly basis, over **53 MILLION** items are processed by textile services to end users in the UK.
- A hotel with 100 rooms uses around **750 PIECES** of linen daily.
- An estimated **13 MILLION** items are processed by the healthcare sector each week.
